Outbreak	A sudden occurrence of something unwelcome, such as war.
Evacuation	The action of evacuating a person or a place.
Rationing	Limiting goods, allowing each person to have only a fixed amount of something.
Air raid	An attack in which bombs are dropped from an aircraft onto a ground target.
