Key Enquiry Question: What was life like for children during WW2?

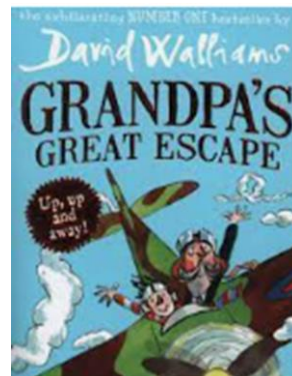

### Key vocabulary

Word	Meaning
War	A state of armed conflict between different countries or different groups within a country.
Evacuee	A person evacuated from a place of danger.
Ration	A fixed amount of a commodity officially allowed to each person during a time of shortage, as in wartime.
Trench	A long, narrow ditch.
Evacuation	To move people from places that are unsafe.

### Sticky Knowledge:

Children were evacuated from London to rural areas.

Evacuee is someone that has been moved from somewhere unsafe to a place of safety.

Children were evacuated because of the war.

World War 2 began because of Adolf Hitler's invasion of Poland.

Many Jewish people were killed in concentration camps.
