Word	Meaning
Wattle	The weaving of twigs to create a wall.
Daub	A mixture of clay, mud and water used to coat a surface.
Weave	Pieces of material are woven in different patterns to create structure.
Evaluate	Assess a design against the criteria or original plan

Sticky Knowledge:

Water needs to be added to a clay/ mud mixture to create daub.

Daub helps cement and insulate a building.

A constantly burning fire is in the middle of each roundhouse.
