#### Key Enquiry: Changing me

##### National Curriculum Objectives

- Know that in animals and humans lots of changes happen between conception and growing up
- Know that in nature it is usually the female that carries the baby
- Know that in humans a mother carries the baby in her uterus (womb) and this is where it develops
- Know that babies need love and care from their parents/carers
- Know some of the changes that happen between being a baby and a child
- Know that the male and female body needs to change at puberty so their bodies can make babies when they are adults
- Know some of the outside body changes that happen during puberty
- Know some of the changes on the inside that happen during puberty

##### Key vocabulary

Word	Meaning
Womb	The womb (uterus) is a pear-shaped organ where a baby is carried during pregnancy.
Conception	The action of creating a child.
Ova	An egg produced by a woman.
Stereotypes	Idea of what a person should do, look-like or act like?

##### Sticky Knowledge:

- Boys and girls have different genitalia and reproductive organs. It is important we know what these are called so we understand our bodies.
- It is important to know our bodies change during puberty. Girls start to develop breasts. Both boys and girls start to grow hair in their armpits and around their pubic areas. Boys voices 'break' (deepen) and they start to grow facial hair
- You should discuss the challenges of puberty with a trusted adult.
