Location	A place or position.
Pollution	The presence in or introduction into the environment of a substance which has harmful or poisonous effects.
Litter	Rubbish which is left lying in public places.
Graph	Used to represent data using a clear picture.
Carbon footprint	A measure of the amount of carbon dioxide released into the atmosphere as a result of the activities of a particular individual, organization, or community.
Vandalism	An action involving deliberate destruction of or damage to public or private property.
