

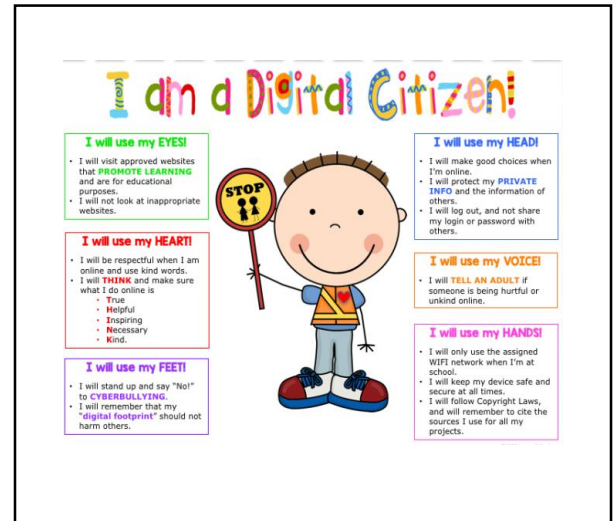

#### Key vocabulary

| Word        | Meaning   |
|-------------|---|
| Hashtag - # | Indicates that you want to participate in a larger, ongoing conversation            |
| Tweet       | Posting short messages for anyone who follows you on Twitter                        |
| Follow      | Represents a user who chooses to see all another user's posts in their content feed |
| Chatroom    | Are online spaces where users communicate with one another                          |

#### Sticky Knowledge:

- Being online can impact our emotions, mental wellbeing and even on our physical health
- Know the SMART Internet Rules:
  - S for Safe: Keep personal details away from strangers.
  - M for Meet: Don't meet people that you know online unless you're with a trusted adult.
  - A for Accept: Don't click any links that you're unsure about. ...
  - R for Reliable: Don't believe everything people tell you. ...
  - T for Tell: If you see something online that upsets you, tell a trusted adult straight away!
