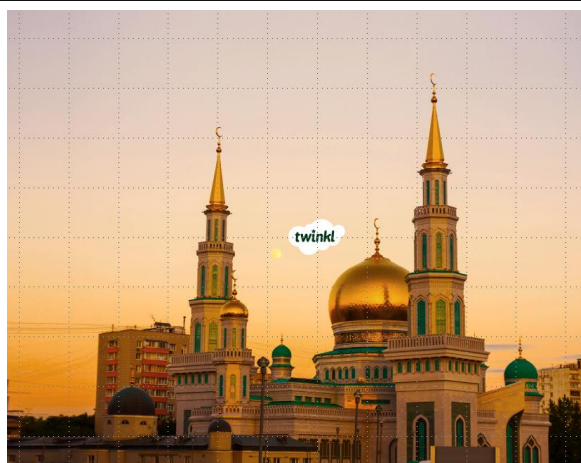


## Religious Education Knowledge Organiser – Islam

Key Enquiry Question: Does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims lead good lives? (Part 2)

### Learning Objective

- We are learning that the concept of Jihad can be interpreted differently leading to different actions and consequences.



Key Vocabulary	Meaning
Akhirah	Muslim belief in life after death.
Muhammad	The final prophet
Qu'ran	The Holy book of Islam revealed to the Prophet Muhammad.
Five Pillars	The framework of the Muslim life. They are the testimony of faith, prayer, giving zakah (support of the needy), fasting during the month of Ramadan, and the pilgrimage to Makkah once in a lifetime for those who are able.
Jihad	Personal individual struggle against evil / making effort.
Ummah	World-wide community of Muslims the nation of Islam.

### Sticky Knowledge

- Allah is in charge on the Day of Judgement.
- Everyone who has ever lived is judged on the Day of Judgement.
- Jannah means Heaven.
- The 'recording angels' record all our good and bad deeds.
- Heaven is described as a garden in the Qur'an.
