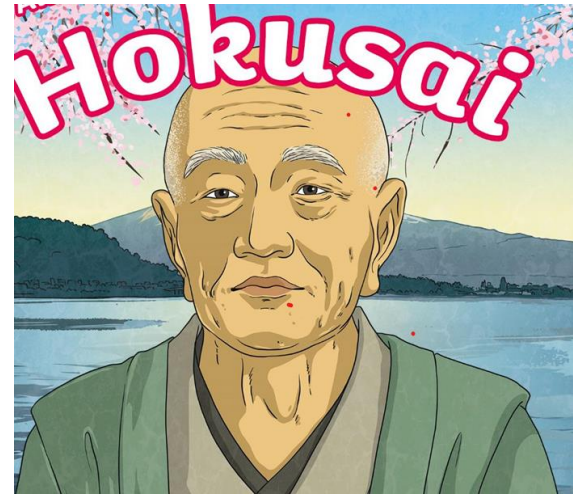


TERMS 3 and 4 ART UKS2 KNOWLEDGE ORGANISER- Hokusai

Key Vocabulary	
develop	Show improvement and change
refine	Make changes so as to improve
light	The amount of light on the subject. If there is light, there is shadow.
colour	Colour is produced when light, striking an object, is reflected back to the eye.
line	A line is a mark made on a surface that joins different points. Lines can vary in length, width, direction and shape.
tone	The relative lightness or darkness of a colour. One colour can have an almost infinite number of different tones. Tone can also mean the colour itself.
