Website	A collection of web pages grouped together.
Copyright	A law that prevents people from copying the creative work of others.
Hyperlinks	Text, buttons, images or moving images that are used to move from one web page to another.

Sticky Knowledge:

Websites are made from multiple web pages that have been created for a purpose.

Copyright laws stop people from using content that was created by another person without permission.

Hyperlinks help people to navigate around a website.
