Key vocabulary

Word	Meaning
Fort	A fortified building or strategic position
Moat	A deep, wide ditch surrounding a castle, fort, or town, typically filled with water and intended as a defence against attack.
Invasion	An instance of invading a country or region with an armed force
Continuity	The unbroken and consistent existence or operation of something over time
Chronological Order	The arrangement of events by time
Change	Alter or modify
