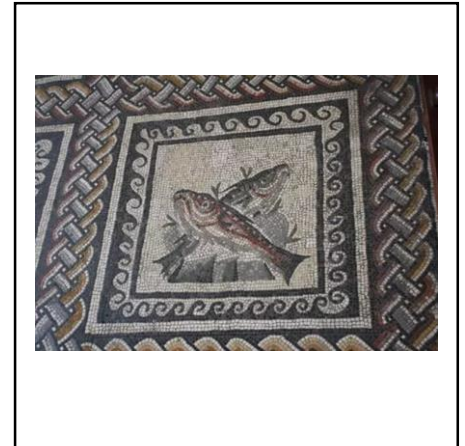

#### Key Vocabulary

mosaic	A picture or pattern produced by arranging together small pieces of stone, tile, glass, etc.
scoring	Creating a precise scratch across the surface of a tile or piece of glass before snapping it.
base	The surface on which the mosaic will be installed.
grout	Cement-based mixture used to fill the joints between tiles and protect the surface from dirt and moisture.

#### Sticky Knowledge:

- Mosaics are used for decoration in roman villas.
- Mosaics are typically made out of tiles and there must be a gap placed between each one.
- Repeated patterns are used to make intricate designs.
- Using different tools can make different textures in clay.
