Key Enquiry Question: How can we make a basket for Little Red Riding Hood?

- Use weaving to create a pattern.
- Join materials using glue and/or a stitch.
- Use plaiting.

Key vocabulary

Word	Meaning
Pattern	A decorative design.
Weave	A way of interlocking threads or strings.
Plait	A braid.
Dip dye	A way to change the colour of fabric.
Glue	A method of sticking things together.
Stitch	Threading a needle through pieces of fabric to sew them together.

Sticky Knowledge:

A basket is used to carry items around.

Most baskets are woven by threading materials in and out of a frame.

Materials can be joined in many different ways, using stitching, gluing, sticking with tape or weaving.

A strong basket will not break and drop the contents.
