Key Enquiry Question: How many oceans and continents are there in the World?

National Curriculum Objectives:

- Name and locate the world's 7 continents and 5 oceans.
- Name, locate and identify characteristics of the 4 countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas.
- Use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries, as well as the countries, continents and oceans studied at this key stage.

Oceans	A large body of water surrounding a continent
Continent	An area of land with different countries in.
Capital city	The main city within a country
Country	A state or a nation

Sticky Knowledge:

There are 7 continents in the world: Europe, Asia, Antarctica, Australasia, North America, South America, Africa.

There are 5 oceans: Pacific, Atlantic, Southern, Indian, Arctic.

A continent is an area of land that is surrounded by the ocean.

A country is a state or a nation within a continent.

A capital city is the main city in a country.

England's capital city is London. We live in Ludgershall which is a town.
