

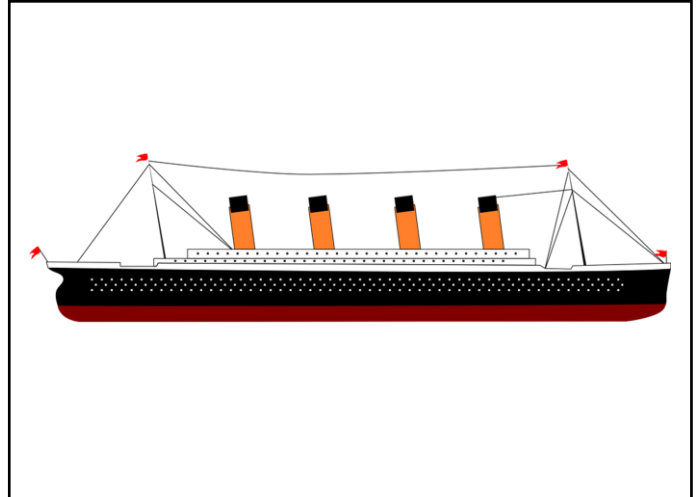
KS1 Under the Sea History Knowledge Organiser

Key Enquiry Question: How has travel on the oceans changed over time?

National Curriculum Objectives:

- Study events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally
- Study changes within living memory.



Key vocabulary

Word	Meaning
Beach	A narrow piece of land separating the ocean and inland areas.
Iceberg	A large chunk of ice that float in the ocean.
Bathing machine	A small hut on wheels that can be pulled into the sea.
Life boat	A small boat carried on a ship in case of emergencies.
Atlantic Ocean	The ocean in which the titanic sunk.

Sticky Knowledge / Golden Thread (hierarchy):

The Titanic was the biggest ship of its time.

It left Southampton on its first voyage in 1912 heading for America. On April 15th it hit an iceberg and sank in the Atlantic Ocean.

There were only 20 life boats on the ship.

Bathing Machines were used so people could change their clothes at the seaside.
