Key vocabulary

Word	Meaning
Shabbat	Day of spiritual renewal and rest beginning at sunset on a Friday and finishing at nightfall on Saturday
Challah	Bread eaten on Shabbat, usually plaited

Sticky Knowledge

Shabbat is the fourth commandment 'You shall remember to keep the Sabbath day Holy'

Jewish people celebrate Shabbat on Saturdays, they prepare every Friday evening
