### **Key vocabulary**

<b>Word</b>	<b>Meaning</b>
Human Feature	Things that have been built by people.
Physical Feature	Things that are made by nature.
Castle	A large building used to protect people from attacks.
Town	An area with streets and buildings where people live and work.
City	A large town
Village	A group of houses and buildings, smaller than a town, situated in a rural area.
Factory	A building or group of buildings where goods are manufactured or assembled.

Castles are usually built on hills.

Castles were built to protect Kings, Queens and Noblemen.

Ludgershall has a castle.

A human feature has been made by man and includes; towers, moats, drawbridges and arrow loop windows.
