Word	Meaning
King	A male head of the Royal Family.
Queen	A female head of the Royal Family.
Royal	Connected to a king or queen.
Past	Something that has already happened.
Event	Something important that has happened.
Monarch	A King or Queen.
Throne	The chair that the King or Queen sits on.

Sticky Knowledge / Golden Thread (hierarchy):

King Charles III is our current reigning monarch because the Queen died.

King Charles III has two sons.

Prince William will become King if King Charles III dies.
