Sculpture

- Use rolled up paper, straws, paper, card and clay as materials.
- Use techniques such as rolling, cutting, moulding and carving.

Texture	The feel and look of a surface.
Carving	Using tools to shape a material.
Rolling	Moving by turning over and over.
Cutting	The action of cutting and making something smaller and trimmed.
Moulding	Give shape to a material.
