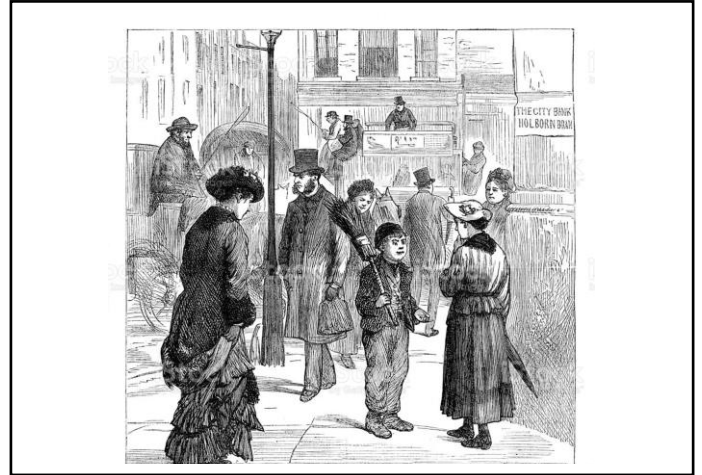
Key Enquiry Question: How were children's lives in Victorian times different to now?

National Curriculum Objectives:

Key vocabulary

Word	Meaning
Cane	The stick used to punish children.
Workhouse	Places where poor people, including children, would live in exchange for working. The conditions were very bad.
Reign	The time that someone is King or Queen
Upper Class	Wealthy people, who usually has servants

Sticky Knowledge / Golden Thread (hierarchy):

The Victorians were the people who lived during the reign of Queen Victoria.

The poor worked in workhouses and factories. Some children had to climb up chimneys to clean them.

Victorian schools were for boys and girls. Girls had to sit on one side and boys the other. They learned the three 'R's.

They wrote on blackboards and some children were punished with the cane.
