Key Enquiry Question: How important is it for Jewish people to do what God asks them to do?

Key vocabulary

Word	Meaning
respect	Thinking about the thoughts and feelings of others when we do something.
Seder meal	Traditional meal eaten during Passover.
Israelites	A person born in Israel during the time of the Bible stories.
Synagogue	A building where Jewish people meet to pray.

Sticky Knowledge:

- Jewish families have a special meal once a year called the Seder Meal.
- The Seder meal is part of their Passover celebrations.
- Special foods are eaten during the Seder meal, such as charoset and matzo crackers.
- Jews believe that God helped the Israelites to be freed.
