Word	Meaning
Bar Mitzvah	A special ceremony for a Jewish boy to welcomed in to the religion.
Bat Mitzvah	A special ceremony for a Jewish girl to welcomed in to the religion.
Commitment	A promise or agreement to do something.
Ceremony	An event done in a certain way to make it a special occasion.
